

# T. B. Scott Free Library Video Book Trailer Contest Rules

1. Video submissions must be original works, produced by the middle school-aged students.
2. Videos should demonstrate that the creators read the book promoted in the book trailer, without giving away the ending.
3. Submissions may be made by individuals or by teams of two middle school students.
4. Videos should be between one and two minutes in length.
5. Credit for information, quotations, images, and background videos should be given in MLA or APA format at the end of the video.
6. The video should be about a book that is appropriate for middle school students, as determined by T. B. Scott Free Library staff.
7. The video should use language and images that are appropriate for middle school students.
8. The video should be free of grammatical, punctuation, and spelling errors.
9. Video or animation apps may be used in the production of the video.
10. Videos should be submitted by e-mail to [tbscottbooktrailers2017@gmail.com](mailto:tbscottbooktrailers2017@gmail.com) or on a thumb drive to the T. B. Scott Free Library youth services desk by 6:00 p.m. on Friday, April 28, along with the student's name and contact information for the purposes of giving credit for videos and awarding prizes. Students may return to pick up a thumb drive labeled with the student's name within a week of the date that it was submitted.
11. By submitting the video, you are giving permission to use it in a T. B. Scott Free Library Summer Library Program promotion.
12. Some qualified videos may not be used in the summer library promotion production.
